

Baby Tooth Care

Here at Dino Kid's Dentistry, we always look forward to seeing some of our very favorite little patients...the babies! Did you know that baby

teeth come in before a year of age, and babies can get cavities before their first birthday?

There are some great recommendations from the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry (AAPD) for you to care for your baby's teeth:

- · Start brushing twice daily with a smear (very small amount) of fluoride toothpaste once the first tooth appears.
- · Once the baby is eating solids, feed a variety of finger foods. Fresh fruit is a great way to enjoy a healthy sweet treat! Avoid candy and sticky sweets.
- · Avoid bottles at night once especially after a year of age. Brush teeth after the baby has a bottle or nurses before bed.
- · Avoid cow's milk, juice, or other sweet drinks in a bottle or sippy cup.
- Check the baby teeth when you brush them. Look for any signs of white spots especially near the gum line. These can be a sign of early cavities.
- · Call your dentist if you notice white spots, bleeding, or anything else concerning.

When is a good time to take the baby to the dentist? The AAPD recommends the first dental visit be near the baby's first birthday, or before, if there are any problems or concerns.
